Dr. Vida S. Huber

Vida Huber was an integral part of both James Madison University and her community. She was a visionary in the field of health and human service; her efforts to improve the quality of life for others touched the lives of many and inspired all. Through her vision the Institute in Health and Human Services (IIHHS) was founded at JMU. The Institute probably best represents Vida's professional beliefs and values and the results of her abilities to foster connections, encourage teaming, and form strategic partnerships.

You may be aware that Vida had announced her intent to retire from James Madison University at the end of the 2005-2006 academic session. At that time, with agreement from Harold Huber, a decision was made to honor Vida with an endowed fund in her name that would support the Institute. Upon her passing that effort did not fall by the wayside.
